Job Title: Research Fellow –Data Governance

Department: Strathmore University – Centre for Intellectual Property and Information Technology Law (CIPIT)

Reporting to: Director, CIPIT; Research Manager, CIPIT

Basic job Summary: CIPIT is launching a Data Governance Research Centre (DGRC). The DGRC is a centre within CIPIT that will centralize all CIPIT research into issues of data governance. The purpose of this Research Fellow position is to plan, coordinate, and implement research projects under the DGRC, in accordance with University strategy, policy and procedures, and the funder requirements.

Duties & Responsibilities:

1. Undertake research activities and investigations in collaboration with and under the supervision of the Research Manager and the Director in order to realize the objectives and development of the specific research programmes for the DGRC.
2. Work as Principal Investigator or Co-Investigator on IT Research Projects, specifically those related to Data Governance, being mutually supportive and covering duties as necessary during colleagues' absences and at times of additional pressure, as directed.
3. Responsible for studying the existing policies and procedures in the countries of study that ensure data is used and governed properly.
4. Convene, facilitate, and support data governance meetings, both internally at Strathmore and externally with stakeholders.
5. Develop high quality reports, academic papers and journal articles of publishable standard based on the analysis of data and literature with a clear and engaging writing style.
6. Develop ideas for generating research funding, promoting research and influencing leading edge research practice.
7. Make presentations at national or international conferences or exhibit work in other appropriate events of a similar standing and identify ways to disseminate research outputs informally via various forms of public engagement.



8. Coordinate output (including the CIPIT blog, podcast, and other platforms), including contributing articles and reviewing guest posts as well as write and edit various publications, and assist with communication of research reports related to Data Governance.
9. Assist the Research Manager and Director on any CIPIT projects or activities having a data-relevant component.

Minimum Requirements: Core Qualifications

- Minimum of a master's degree in Law, Political Science or a relevant Social Science. Candidates with a PhD will be considered favourably.
- Relevant experience in research in law/policy for ICT, and particularly Data Governance. 2 years relevant working experience or more is preferred.
- Only candidates willing to take a **full-time position** will be considered.
- Possess sufficient specialist knowledge in the discipline of ICT law/policy to develop research programmes and methodologies. Special consideration will be given for national or international recognition as an authority in the subject area.
- Extensive experience in establishing and executing data governance or data engagement programs.
- Demonstrated knowledge and skills in enterprise data management, data governance, and data quality principles and methodologies.
- Demonstrated experience in cross collaborating with multiple teams – change management and communications planning and execution expertise is a plus
- Ability to effectively challenge all levels of an organization and offer value-add solutions to meet data governance objectives. Strong experience in stakeholder engagement and people and relationships management is required.
- Proven academic track record and a strong publication record.
- Experience of managing research projects and teams.
